FN Report

- May Events were Good
 - o Fr. Jennings' Presentation
 - Memorial Day Ceremony
 - SK Wayne Straight was the lead
 - · Nice ceremonial honoring the military
 - · Fr. Martin led group in a prayer
 - Honored SK Chuck Burnett for service during the Vietnam Era
 - · Forty some Knights, Sir Knights and Parishioners processed and place flags by silhouettes in front of St. Luke's Church
 - · SK Wayne Straight thanked all for their service



- FN stated that SK Charlie O'Brien wants to pursue Color Guard
 - o Replace legacy uniform with new modern uniform
 - Cost approximately \$450 down from the initial cost of \$600
 - Between the Council and Assembly, they will cover \$200 of the cost
 - FN stated that the Assembly is willing to cover \$200 vice only \$100
 - Total reimbursement would be \$300 vice \$200
 - SK would pay approximately \$150 vice \$450
 - SK Chuck McCready only SK who has currently purchase uniform
 - No real option/choice but use the new uniform for ceremonies
 - Need six (6) or eight (8) Sir Knights to volunteer for Color Guard
- FN opened the floor for discussion
 - SK Ron Ruest stated the meaning of a 'uniform'
 - SK Eddie Mardaga suggested check at Boscov's
 - Comments were it could be more costly
 - Products may not be same as 'official' uniform
 - Negates the concept of uniform
 - SK Lou Guido stated if we are going to reestablish the Color Guard, we should do it correctly
 - SK Tom Anderson stated his position is ideological don't use new uniform
 - Supreme did not asked for input
 - Dark suits with Social Baldric and gloves would work
 - SK Ruest said that concept negates 'uniform' appearance
 - o FN Herwig stated that other Council have the new uniform despite the fact they don't like it
 - Important point is that we are doing it for the Church and Brother Knights
 - Cost should not be a factor since Council and Assembly are paying three-quarters (¾) of the price
 - SK Joe Lazarri stated that he is against the change
 - Wearing a suit is okay but not a uniform
 - SK Jim Stone stated that he would join and asked who else would join
 - The following individuals raised their hands:

 - SK Tom Pergola
 - FP Richard Thomas stated out of respect, Assembly should ask SK Neil Foote since he was the last Commander
 - FN stated that he would call SK Foote and ask him if he would be the Commander
 - Suggestion made that if SK Foote declines, maybe SK Richard Thomas, the Assistant Commander could move up
 - Final Decision tabled until September Assembly Meeting



- o SK Wayne Straight introduced the fact that the Assembly needs someone to take measurements
 - SK Charlie McCready suggested his tailor in Ocean Pines (Berlin)
 - Tailor would measure for free with stipulation that Sir Knights returns to this store for alterations
 - Each Sir Knights would pay for his own alterations
 - FN or designated-SK would contact tailor to see what the shop will do for the Assembly
 - Other topics introduced were requirements for social baldric and shoes
- o FN stated that we will defer further discussion until first meeting in September
 - If anyone has additional input, send it to the FN
- FN introduced Seafood Nights beginning 02 July through 27 August each Tuesday evening
 - o Training 20 July at 11:00 a.m. following Thursday Rosary/Bible Discussion
- FN stated that he is working on an 'Invitation Letter' to all Third Degree Knights to join the Fourth Degree
 - o PFN Joe Kostelac has a copy of the letter which he sent out previously
 - o Approximately 227 potential Third Degree candidates eligible to become Fourth Degree members
 - Council Membership Chair (CMC), Jack Kelley, recently brought in seven (7) new members and two (2) transfers
 - o PGK Jim Matthews had eight (8) men join as new Council members prior to CMC's nine (9)
 - FN stated that he has purchased envelopes and labels, and he needs a committee
 - Five (5) SKs to fold, stuff, label and stamp 'Invitation Letters'
 - Five (5) to ten (10) SKs for a follow-up-team to contact those who don't respond
 - FN to work with officers and CMC in the next few weeks
 - SK Wayne Straight suggested inviting potential candidates to come to a meeting
 - SK Wayne Straight stated that the \$70 initiation fee might be too expensive for some
 - SK Straight suggested sponsors for any candidate who needed financial assistance for the \$70
 - Remind candidates that \$70 is a one-time fee
 - Annual Dues are \$25
